



### **Butterfly Farm Volunteer Role**

Stratford-upon-Avon Butterfly Farm is looking for enthusiastic and passionate volunteers to be in our main tropical butterfly display. The role would involve interacting with the visiting public, answering any questions they may have and monitoring the free-range iguanas and birds that live in the Flight Area.

No previous experience is required as full training will be provided.

All ages over 18 are encouraged to apply.

The role has a minimum term of 1 day per month with flexible hours available between 10:00 and 16:00, Monday-Sunday.

#### **Essential attributes:**

- Keen interest in butterflies and lepidoptera species.
- A general love for nature.
- Confident public speaking skills and be able to inform and educate the visiting public or a willingness to develop these skills.
- Physically fit as the environment is warm and humid.
- Be able to work independently and as part of a team.

#### **What you can gain from this role:**

- Working in a friendly environment. All members of staff are there to help and we want volunteers to feel comfortable and enjoy working at the butterfly farm.
- Gain a better understanding about tropical butterflies and the other free-range species that live in the main flight area. Knowledge of the natural world is always growing and changing so in this role you never really stop learning.
- Being surrounded by nature in a beautiful rainforest setting.
- Gain confidence talking to people and engaging with the visiting public.

Successful volunteers will be subject to an interview and a trial shift. Once enrolled the successful volunteer will be provided with full training, uniform, 20% staff discount in the gift shop and a complimentary family entrance ticket.
